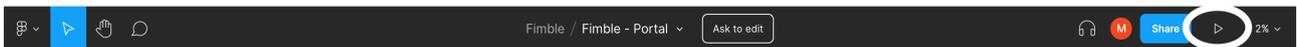


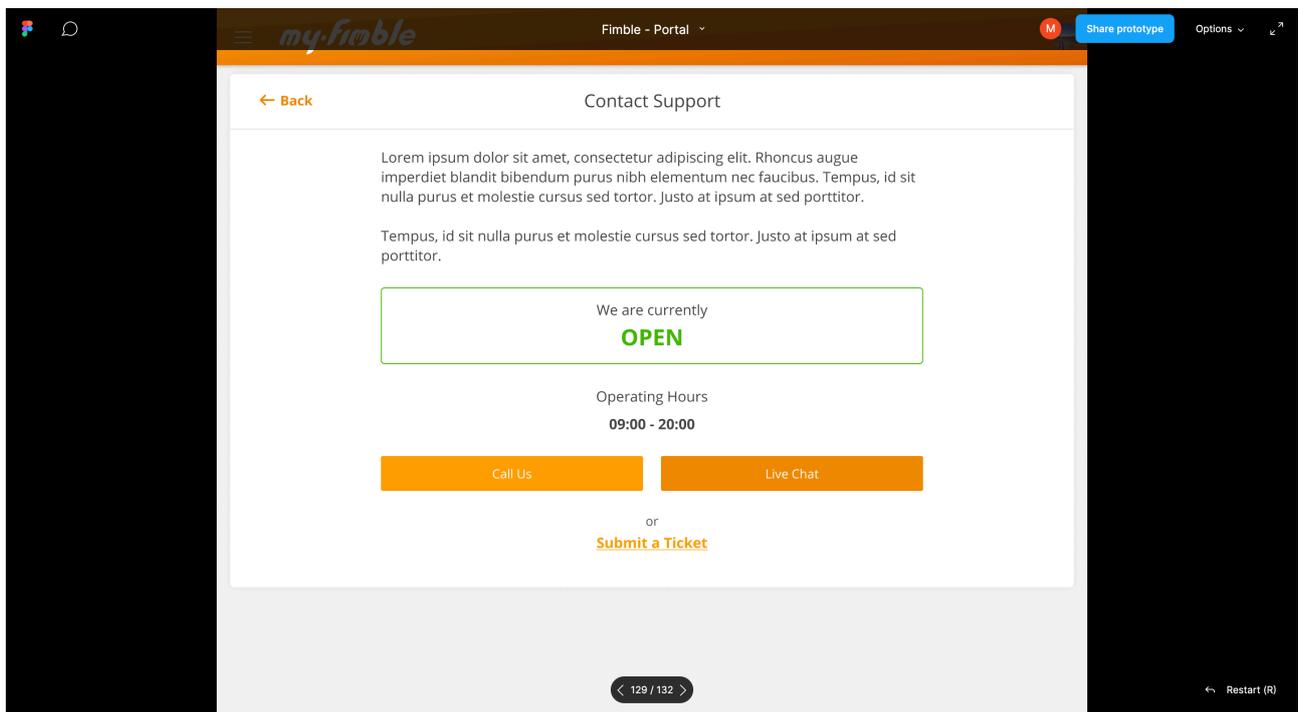
Figma Tutorial

Present your designs

1. Click this  button in the toolbar to access Presentation view from any file.



After you open presentation view, your screen should be looking like that:



2. From Presentation view you can:

- A. Click  show and hide the left sidebar.
- B. Click  enter comment mode and add comments to the prototype.
- C. View and select flows
- D. View a flow's description
- E. Set the prototype view Options 

F. Click  to enter fullscreen mode

G. Figma will present the device against the Background Color you selected

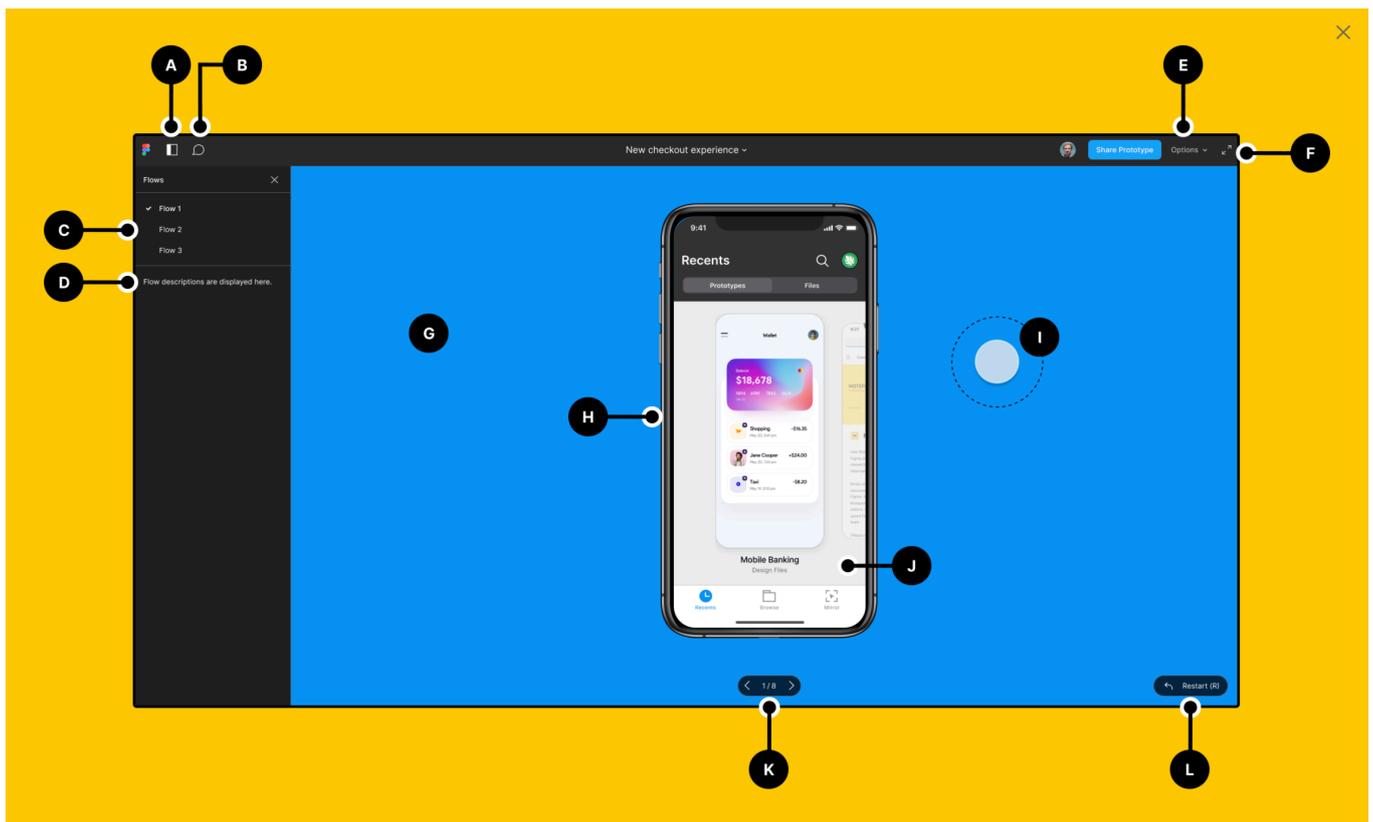
H. View the Device you selected in your prototype settings

I. View your cursor or touch indicator (mobile device prototypes only)

J. Interact with hotspots or enter keyboard shortcuts within your prototype

K. Use the arrow keys to move between screens.

L. Use the Restart button  or press R to return to the starting point

Add a comment

Add a comment to any location on the canvas. If you comment on a top-level frame, component, or group, Figma will attach your comment to that object. Comments won't attach to any nested frames, components, groups, or other layers.

1. Click the comment icon on the top left in the toolbar, or press the “C” key.
2. Your cursor will turn into a location icon. Click on the location in the canvas you'd like the comment to appear.
3. Type your message in the field. Click the emoji icon to add emoji or type “@” to mention a colleague or collaborator.
4. Click Post to send your message.
5. After you post a message we get notified and start working on it. If we need any further explanation we will comment back and you will receive a notification.
