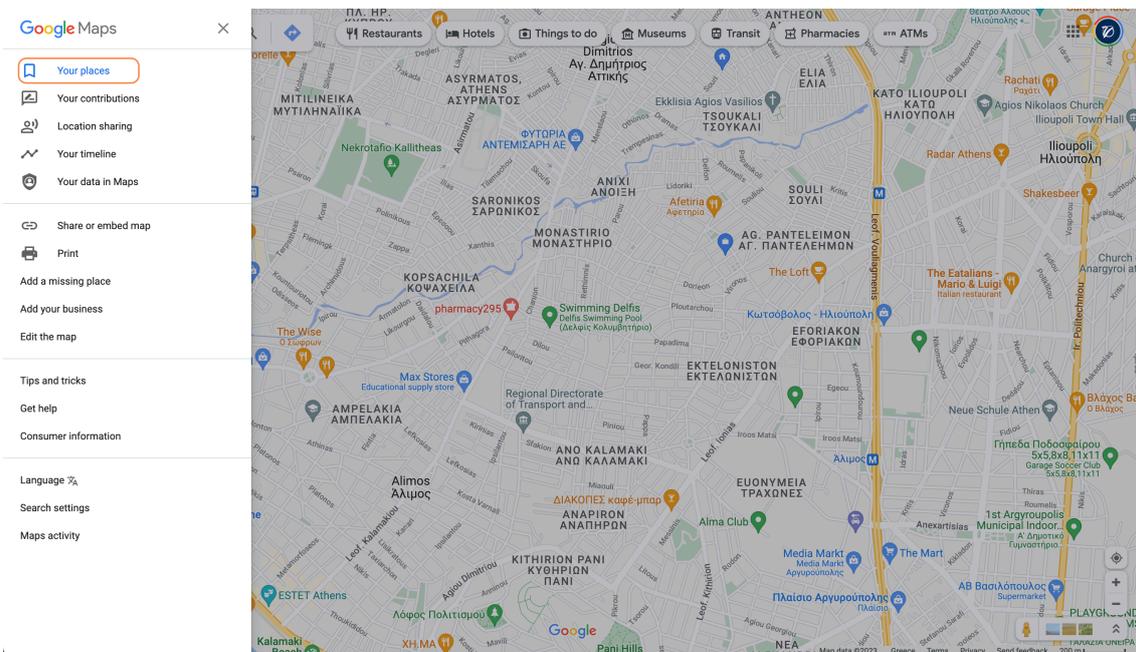




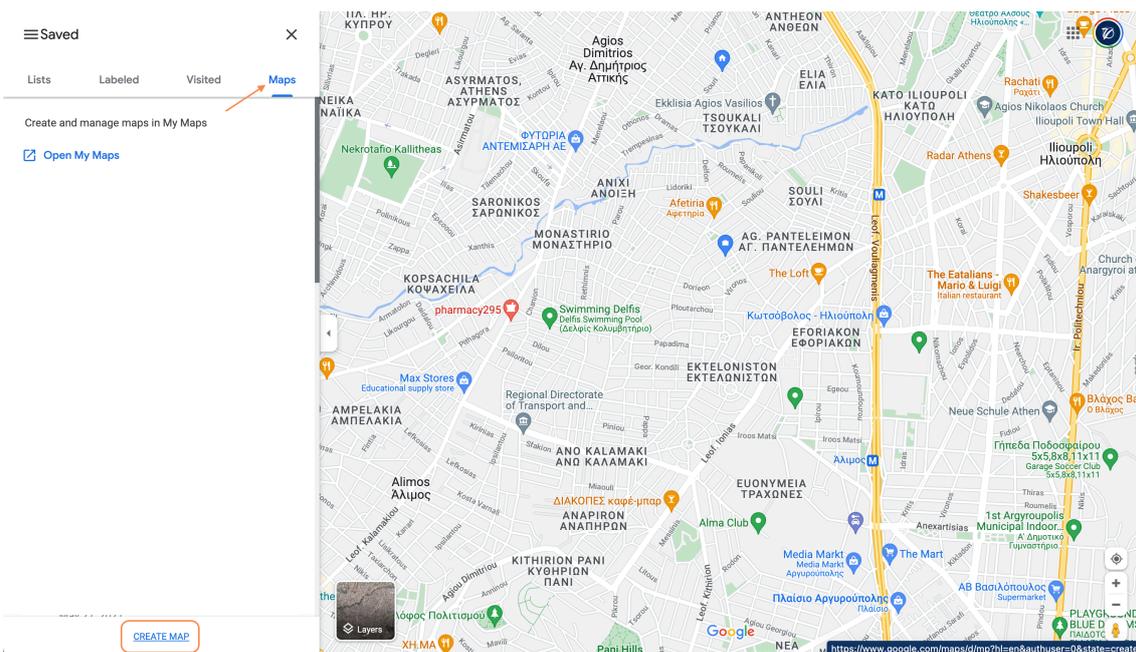
Google Maps KML files

Create KML files

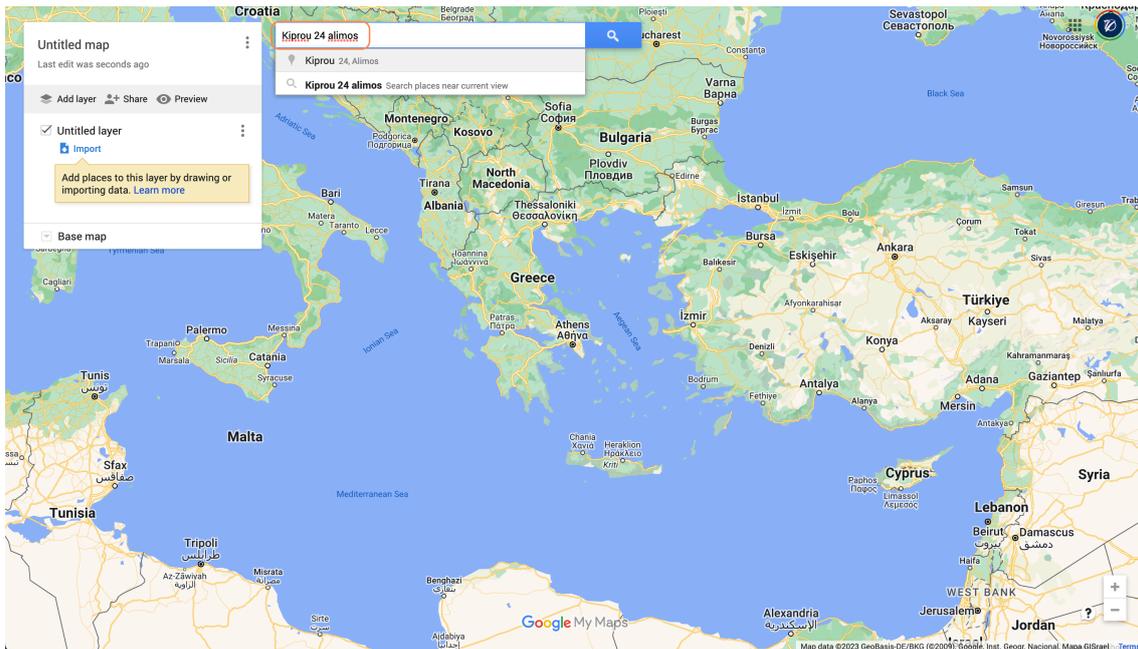
- You should first go to Google Maps using a Google account of yours, preferably a corporate one
- Hit the sidebar button and click on **Your Places**



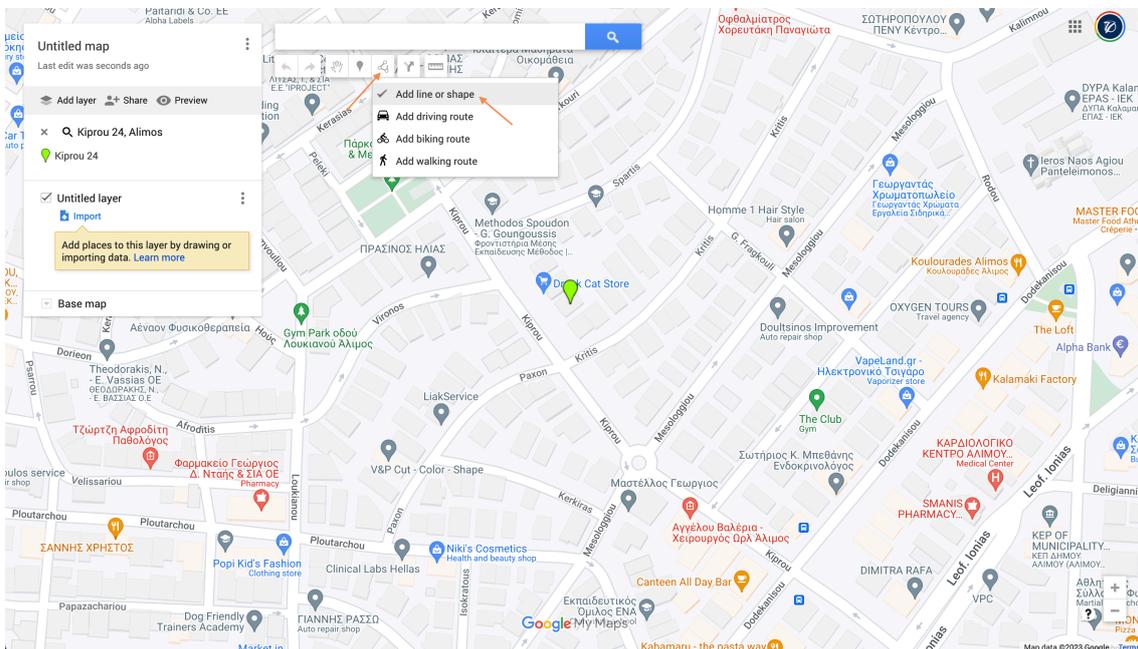
- Select **Maps** and hit **Create Map** button



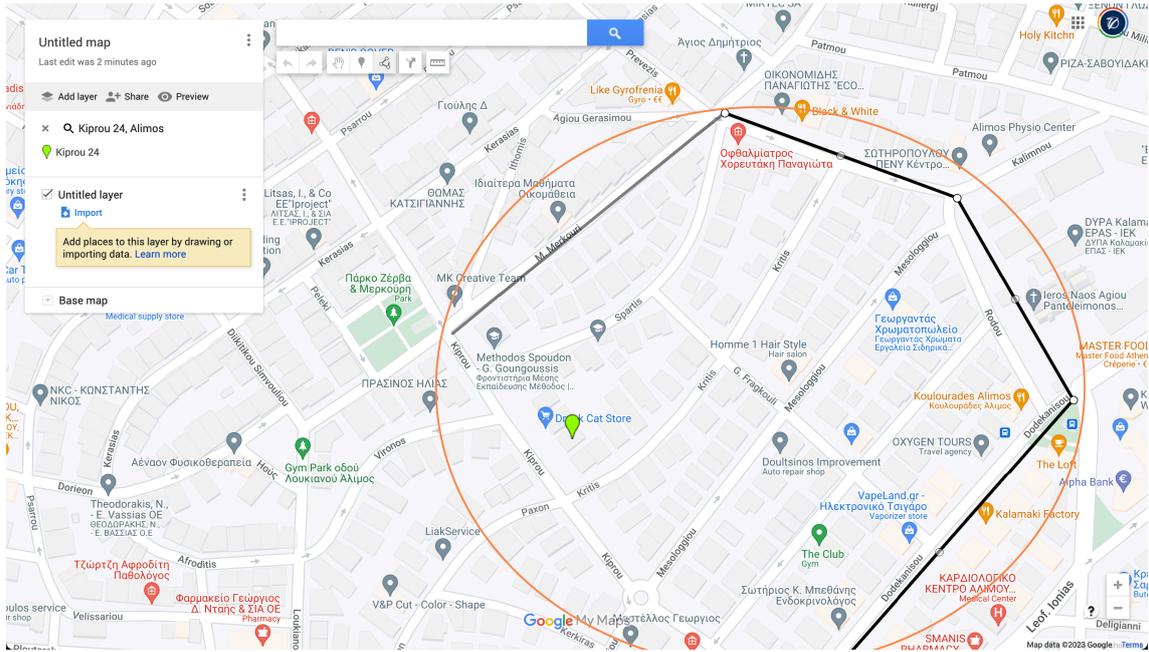
- System will open a new browser tab. Search the location / boundary you are interested in and select among the provided results



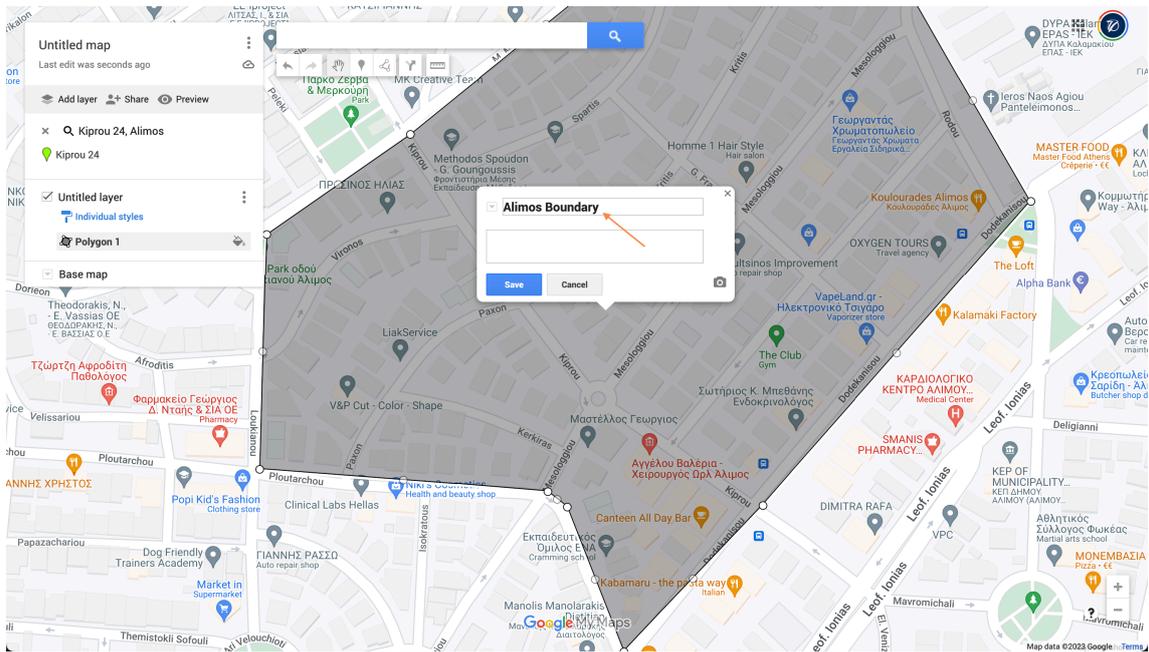
- Hit the highlighted button right below the search bar then select **Add line or shape**



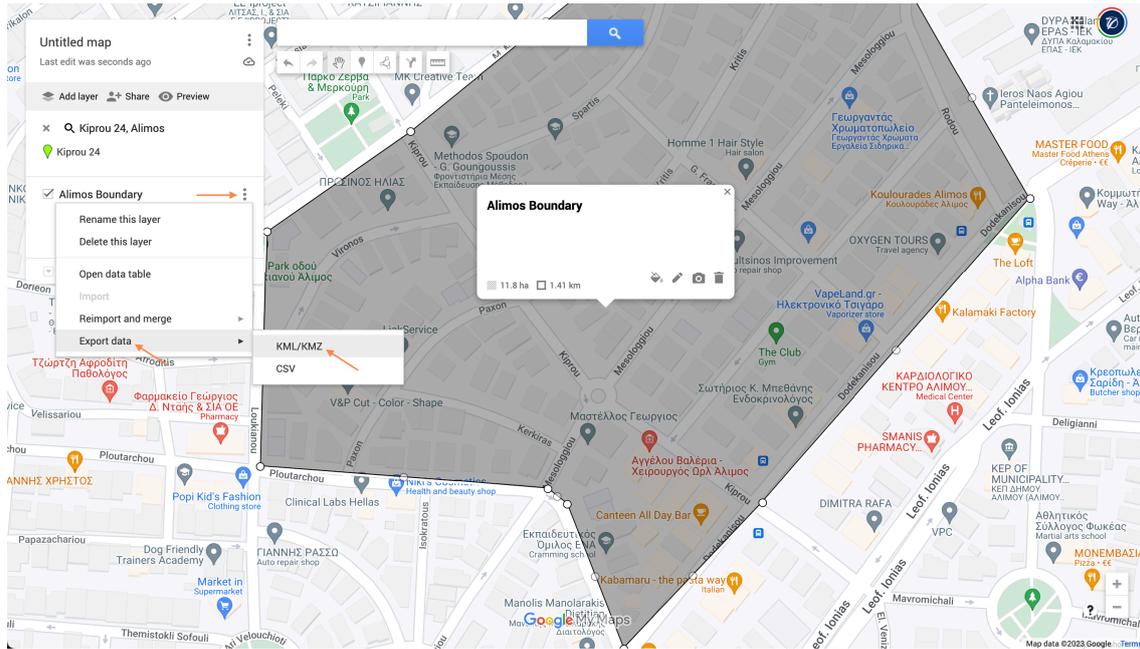
● Start defining the area you want to mark by clicking over the map



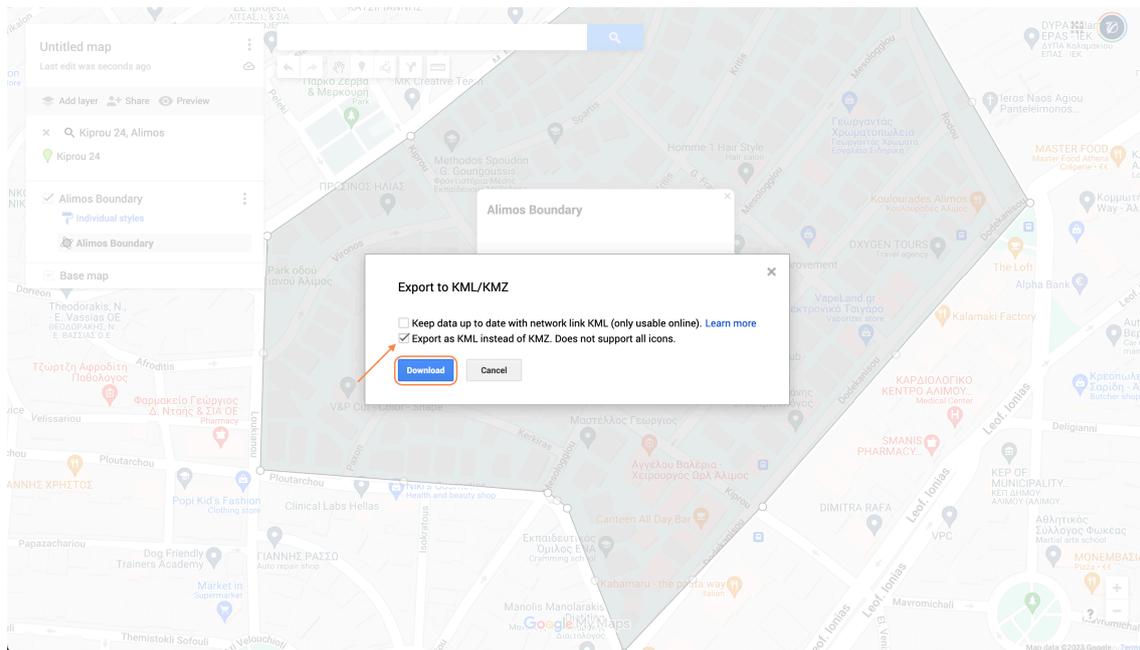
● After finishing the marking process, please give a name to your area



- Hit Options (3 dots) button right next to your boundary, go to **Export data** and select **KML/KMZ**



- Select **Export as KML** instead of **KMZ** then proceed to **Download**



After finishing the above process, send over the KML files to iProject in order to migrate to Fimble.
